LENT 2021

The joyful season of Lent begins on Wednesday when Ashes will be blessed and imposed at the Masses in the morning and the evening. Because of the Covid precautions the Ashes will not be marked upon the forehead but will be sprinkled on the top of the head so as to minimise contact. (This is, in fact, the way the clergy always used to receive them, the Ashes being sprinkled on the Tonsure or shaved portion of the head which was a mark of the clergy.) As last year, you do not have to look for any special penances during Lent. Just patiently endure all the restrictions imposed on us and offer them up in union with Our Lord in his fast and temptations in the wilderness.

Septuagesima, Sexagesima, Quinquagesima – these lovely old names for the Sundays before Lent remind us that it is only 70 days before Easter. It is time to start gearing ourselves up for a good Lent which, as last year, will provide its own penances.

FOUNDATION MASSES

These are Masses which are endowed by a donation to be celebrated each year. For a number which have been established for many years the money invested no longer provides a stipend. Therefore, those Masses which have been established for more than 25 years will be extinguished and replaced with one Mass for all Deceased Benefactors of the Parish to be offered annually in November.
